

Chart of Motions






▶ Point of Information

- no second, debate or majority









Point of order

- > Request chair to enforce rules and order
 - taken > correction
 - not taken (explained)
- no second, debate or majority

> Out of order

- > Chair declares an action/motion out of order
 - Member has no right to speak (not recognised)
 - Member deviates from the topic at hand
 - Motion of higher precendence is still pending
